Dear Prime Minister,

We, the Davao Federation of Farmers' Integrated Services Cooperatives, Inc. (DAFISCO), a secondary federation of 54 farmer cooperatives cultivating rice, cacao, coconut, and banana, operating in the Davao Region in the Philippines, a partner organization of We Effect, write to you to express our deep concern on the decision to cut Sweden's official development assistance.

The war in Ukraine has underlined how severely vulnerable groups are affected in times of crisis. Already enduring the economic effects of the Covid-19 pandemic and the climate crisis, people in poverty are now suffering from skyrocketing food prices.

The Secretary-General of the UN warns that 1,7 billion people – one fifth of the world's population– are at risk of hunger and poverty. The world is in the worst humanitarian situation since World War II. Nearly half of humanity lives in the danger zone of climate crisis.

We, Philippine development organizations, bear witness of the UN reports. With this in mind, the historic and tragic decision to cut the development assistance will impact us in unprecedented ways. For us, the cut has drastic implications/effects.
